When she realized the 'and I thought about you' routine would make a great picture book, her professional and personal writing lives converged.

One afternoon, back in the United States, while sitting in Lisa's backyard in Westfield, NJ the two started talking. Lisa, an Associate Director in the finance industry by day, shared with Rosanne her passion for art and her need to keep up with it – despite how busy she was – because it provided a much-needed creative outlet. Rosanne shared with Lisa her passion for writing children's books and suggested Lisa might want to illustrate one. A bit apprehensive, Lisa read the manuscripts and was particularly drawn to 'And I Thought About You.' And the partnership began.

After three years, a new baby, and many changes on the job front, Lisa completed the illustrations and together she and Rosanne researched ways to publish the book.
